Stewarding Texas – A Scientific Exploration

What is *Stewarding Texas*?

Stewarding Texas is a compilation of 40 lessons designed to develop an understanding of land stewardship and conservation within our youth. The integration of stewardship lessons into classrooms statewide will engage both students and teachers, with purpose to 1) achieve awareness, 2) instill stewardship ethic, and 3) inspire them to take action. Every lesson is Science TEKS aligned, intended for use by Kindergarten through Grade 8 students.

What is the cost?

Stewarding Texas is free resource from the Texas Wildlife Association, made available through funding from the [East Foundation](#). We simply ask that you fill out an evaluation at the end of each semester telling us how you incorporated the lessons into your teachings.

How can I access these lessons?

Every Discovery Trunk now includes a printed copy of *Stewarding Texas* and educators can access and download all of the lessons by registering through the online portal on Texas Wildlife Association's website.

What TEKS are covered?

Stewarding Texas is Science TEKS aligned for Grades K-8. To view specific TEKS for each lesson please visit the main page of the online portal to view the TEKS matrix separated per grade level.

Each lesson is available as a PDF. Some lessons will have accompanying PDF activity sheets, videos, and PowerPoints.
