



**WILDLIFE FOR LUNCH
Webinar Series
2017**

The following is a proposed webinar topic to be presented during the Texas Wildlife Association/Texas A&M AgriLife Extension's 2017 Wildlife for Lunch (WFL) Webinar Series. Individuals representing universities, ranches, non-profit organizations, government agencies, and industry may apply. Presentations should be related to wildlife, fisheries, habitat management, or similar topics. No commercial products or services may be advertised or endorsed. Submissions will be reviewed by a committee. Presenters will be asked to allow their presentation to be recorded, and we ask that presentations be "timeless" information so that archived webinars are relevant for many years to come.

WFL Webinars are held the 3rd Thursday of every month. Presentations are generally 45 minutes each, plus 5-10 minutes for Q&A. Webinars will run from 12 Noon – 1:00 PM. TWA hosts the webinars using the WebEx event system and viewers of the live webinar broadcast can ask questions and communicate with the host and presenter. Presenters will need to provide a PowerPoint on the subject matter, schedule and practice the presentation with TWA host (lasts about ½ to 1 hour - usually done Monday or Tuesday the week of the live presentation), and present the live webinar on the scheduled day. TWA will be responsible for publicity, attendance and numbers tracking, recording and posting to internet, etc. We can also provide you with a headset and microphone that plugs into your computer to deliver the presentation.
